

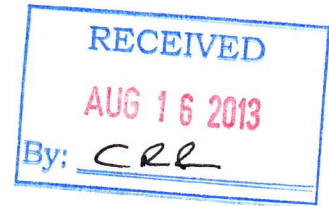


Dear Mr. Stolper and Mr. Massey:

I am pleased to advise you that, based on a review of the documents and materials submitted on August 8, 2013 regarding renewal of your Labor Code §3201.5 letter of eligibility, I have found that the parties continue to meet the eligibility requirements of Labor Code section 3201.5. The terms and conditions for continued eligibility and record keeping and reporting requirements outlined in prior letters of eligibility remain in full force and effect.

This letter of eligibility is effective August 25, 2013, and will expire, as to the group, on August 24, 2016, although it may become ineffective as to an individual employer on an earlier date, if that individual employer no longer carries the required workers' compensation insurance, or is no longer signatory to a current 3201.5 provision, or otherwise fails to meet the eligibility requirements of Section 3201.5.

Please submit a letter annually outlining any changes as provided by California Code of Regulations §10204(a), in addition to the data required by Labor Code Section 3201.5(i).
